Dear Parents/Carers,

It has now been confirmed by LCC that all schools should close on Monday 8th May 2023 in honour of the coronation of His Majesty King Charles III. This reduces the school year to 188 days (376 sessions).

Most of you will have noticed the amazing work that has gone on over half term to clear the broken playground equipment and make the area safe. We want to thank Mr Hesketh as he has organised the work and completed much of it himself. The area is now a blank canvas for future school developments.

Thank you for your patience with School Spider – the issues have been out of our control and we share your frustration. Mrs Harling is working closely with School Spider to ensure that the issues are resolved and the system will work smoothly as intended.

Please note that no data was breached in the server issue – the information was deleted so all personal and banking information remained secure.
