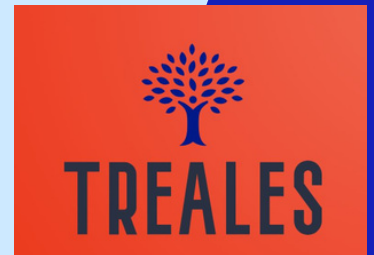

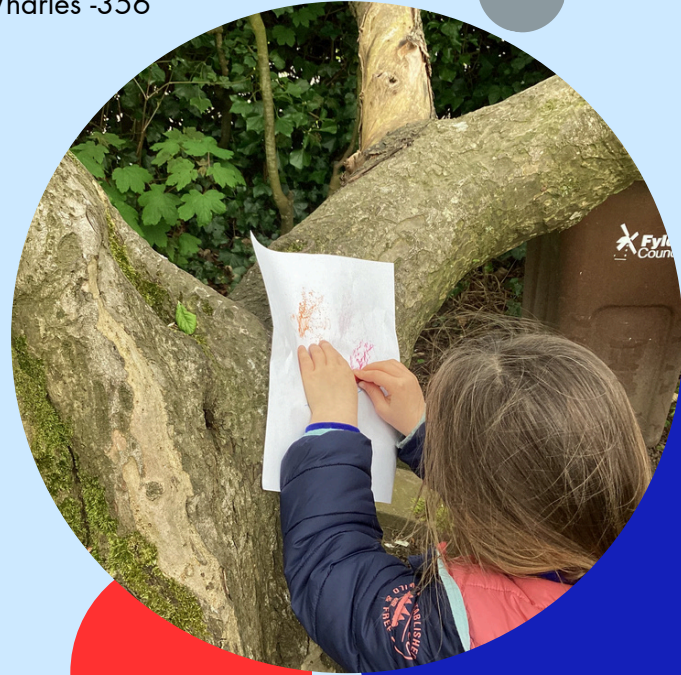

## SUN SAFETY

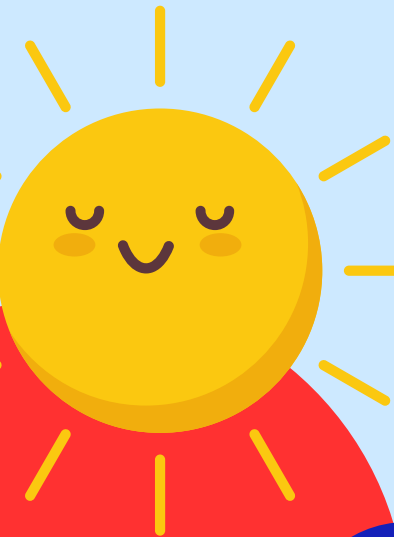
